## **Economic Empowerment Terms**

- 1. Economics: the study of how people work to create wealth.
- 2. Wealth: made up of all the material goods in a society the things we need to survive and the things we want. It includes our abilities to produce goods and services.
- 3. Need: a necessity (food, shelter, clothing).
- 4. Want: a desire (big screen TV, sports car, disco ball).
- 5. Good: objects that can get by purchasing them with money or credit. You can use or consume them. Example: book, hamburger. You buy a good with the idea that you will use it, either just once or over and over again.
- 6. Service: actions performed by people to help others. Examples: someone gives you a haircut. You don't really get something solid, like a book or a CD, but you do get something that you need or want.
- 7. **Production:** how goods are made.
- 8. Distribution: how goods and services are spread around or passed from one group to another.
- 9. Economy: The way goods and services have been produced, distributed, and used by people over the course of time.
- 10. Economic Empowerment: having enough money to meet their needs, and a little extra for the special things they want. It is also called economic security.
